We will also be reading the book 'Zeraffa Giraffa' by Dianne Hofmeyr, which is based on a real-life story, and producing some persuasive writing.

Reading

The children will enjoy exploring parts of the UK through reading the beautiful 'Illustrated Atlas of Britain and Ireland'.

They will also read 'The Egyptian Cinderella' by Shirley Climo and compare it to the traditional story of Cinderella.



Grammar

As part of their writing, they will also focus on inverted commas for direct speech, conjunctions, paragraphs, headings and subheadings.

P.E.

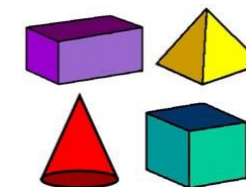
We will continue to develop Tag Rugby skills and enjoy some OAA activities. The children will also develop their athletics skills and enjoy a game of rounders.
